**Intern positions at Oceans Research, previously known as the South African Marine Predator Lab (SAMPLA), will be available throughout the year starting in August 2009.**

Applications from all undergraduate and graduate students qualified, or studying, in the field of science will be readily considered (open water diving qualification a requirement). Participants will be required to join the program for a minimum of 1 month, but preferably for two months or more. Interns will actively participate in the institute's Zambezi shark, and other marine predator research programs. Amongst others, studies on the Zambezi shark include investigating their population dynamics, genetic profiling, and horizontal and vertical movements through acoustic tracking and streamer tagging.

Interns will be hosted by scientists from Oceans Research and their collaborating partners. All conducted research is supported by local universities, such as Eduardo Mondlane University in Maputo, and the University of Pretoria.
