

6th International Symposium on Ozone Applications, V International Symposium on Environment and II ozone therapy International Congress from FIOOT Havana City from June 28th through July 1st, 2010

The Ozone Research Center of Cuba is pleased to invite you to take part in the 6th International Symposium on Ozone Applications, V International Symposium on Environment and II ozone therapy International Congress from FIOOT.

The symposium will be held in the "International Convention Center" at Havana City from June 28th through July 1st, 2010, within the framework of the 15th International Scientific Congress CNIC 2010.

A broad scientific program has been organized with the topics tackled at present by our Center as well as those developed in collaboration with other Cuban institutions during these 30 years of scientific work.

The main subjects in the Symposium will be: Ozone Experimental Medicine and Medical Treatments; Ozone Chemistry; Ozonized Vegetable Oils; Ozone in Food Industry; Treatment of Water, Waste Water and Solid Wastes; Environmental Management; Renewable Energy; Ozone Generation System Design; Corrosion and material protection.

ABSTRACTS:

Although the papers could be presented in either official language of the Congress, Spanish or English, the abstracts will be accepted only in written English and should preferably be sent by email xvc@cnic.edu.cu or simposio@cnic.edu.cu **before March 31th, 2010**. Session and preferred manner of presentation must be indicated. The Organizing Committee will choose and inform the authors on abstracts accepted before April 31th, 2010. It will have the right to decide the manner of presentation which will be informed in due time to the authors.

Poster entries will be admitted to the Last Minute Session until **June 27th, 2010 (12:00 h)**. These posters will be presented in a separate area and they will not be included in the CD-ROM of the congress. Delegates for Last Minute Session will receive the credentials and certificate of attendance.

It is a requisite that at least one author of the paper registers himself and pays the corresponding registration fee.

RULES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:

Use any version of Microsoft Word to make the abstract document, which should be formatted to A4 page size with 2.5 cm margins and as font type use Time New Roman and single line spacing. The document should be saved in MS Word format (DOC) or preferably in Rich Text Format (RTF). The total area shall not exceed one page.

Use a font size of 16 points for the title, which should preferably consists of no more than 20 words.

Author names and affiliations should appear using a font size of 12 and 10 points, respectively. Although there is no limit for the number of authors, we would very appreciate if only the six first authors are included in the abstract to facilitate edition work. Underline the name of the author who is going to present the work.

Provide three to seven keywords for the document.

Limit the body text of the abstract to a maximum of 250 words without including the title, the author names and affiliations. Use a font size of 12 for the body text. The abstract should briefly express the structure of the whole document (Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusions). Please, don't use images, tables, formulae, complex symbols or acronyms in the body text.

The dead line for abstracts submission is March 31th, 2010.

All abstracts will be reviewed by the evaluator committee of the Congress, who will decide the acceptance of submissions as oral presentations or posters. All the abstracts of the accepted works will appear in the official CD-ROM of the congress.
